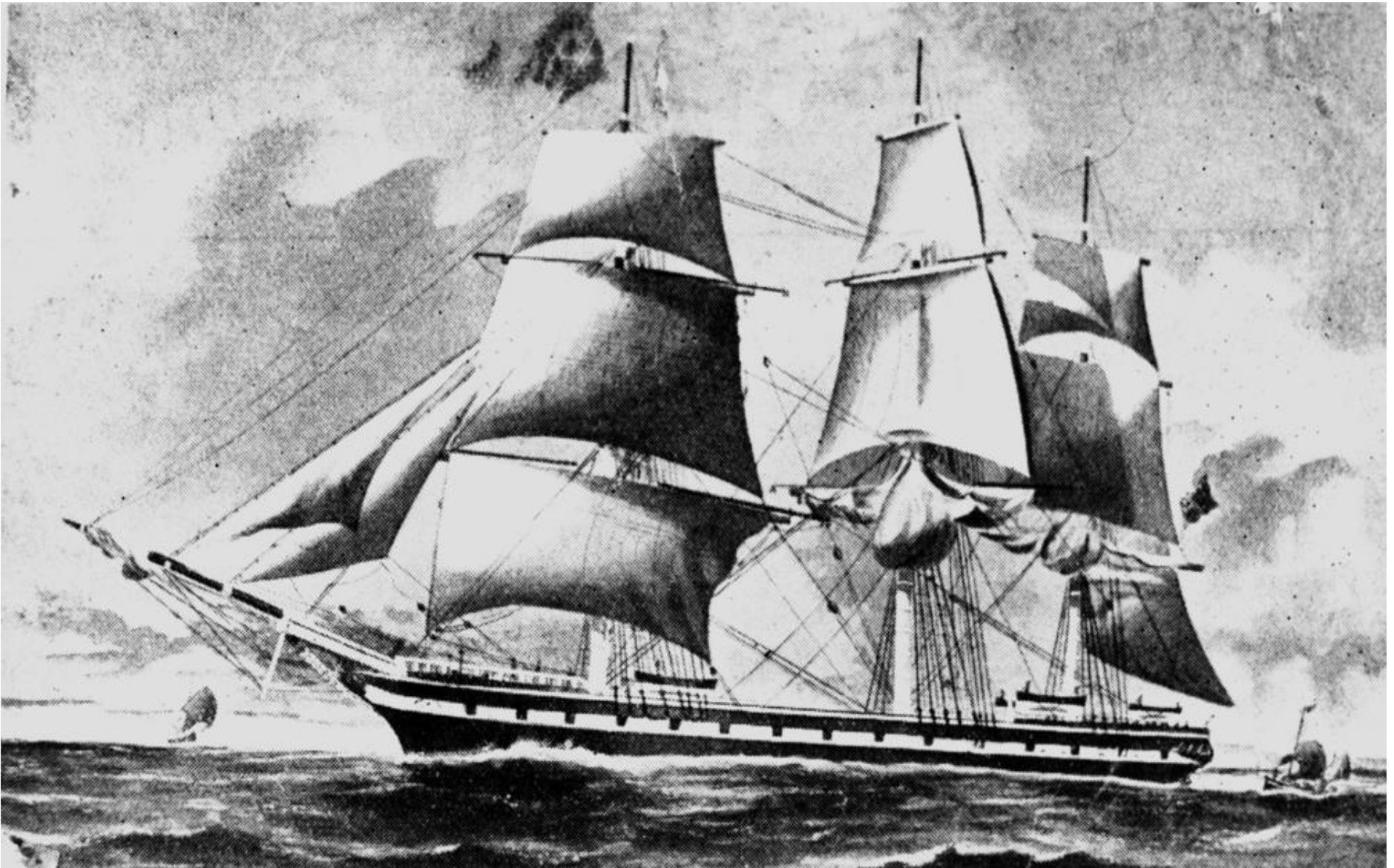


Dunbar Shipwreck 150th Anniversary
